If you do go the ducttape route, get a wife beater (the tank top kind) and put that on first, use a garter belt to hold the shirt down past yr rearend or sew snaps into the crotch.. That way, you don't/won't have to worry too much about the unwrapping pain.. except on the sides where the wifebeater doesn't protect. Imagine that there is a a large X on your chest and bind in that manner. Start at your shoulder, then go from left shoulder to right waist, then around the lower area and up from left waist to right shoulder. You would then pull your breasts to the side and down.. and depending on how low you hang, or how much room you have to pull, it should fill out the side area. I'll try to find some binding and see if I cant get a picture.
