I did two outfits, both of the same character from Yami no Matsuei, Kurosaki Hisoka. One was what I dubbed "ghetto-tastic orange shirt outfit" (because it was truly ghetto; I have a better version of that outfit now) and the other was the light green yukata (and for only those who are clueless here, no offense or anything, think "night under the blood red moon with Muraki").

Starting from Yaoi-con 2004 (first con for me ever), I've been to Anime Destiny '04, AOD '05, Fanime '05, AX '05, JTAF 3, Yaoi-con '05, Otaku Bowl '06 (spring, which was the first one, and summer remix), AOD '06 (Sunday only), Fanime '06, AX '06, Sac-anime '06 just this summer, and JTAF 4. Yaoi-con '06 will be my next con (but not the last, never the last, cons won't be ending for me for a long time). I have yet to go to an out-of-state con, but next year, I will (Sakura-con, anyone?). XD

In terms of Masquerade (a.k.a. cosplay competition), outside of AX '06, I've competed in all of the competitions starting from Otaku Bowl spring, and I will continue to do so, regardless of if I win or not. It's just for fun, you know? I mean, I do admit that I get a little sad and/or upset when I don't win, but I just shrug it off later on as "oh, well, better luck next time".

I've won only one award for my Ed outfit, third place, that is. It was just this year too. I never expected to win, since I never think of myself as very lucky, so it was quite a shock to win that award.

So, to put it simply, I'm a devoted con-goer, yaoi fangirl (of course! Although I'm not fangirl enough to be rabid, I think), crossplayer (someday I will cosplay as well), fanfiction reader and writer, and I love doujinshi (have yet to own a lot), outside of anime and manga. And, I'm always interested in meeting new people at cons. It's fun! :D

At cons, you would typically find me at the Dealer's Room, Video Room (sometimes, depends on what's showing), a panel or two, group photoshoots, hanging out with people, at the Console Game Room (this is recent), taking pictures (I don't tend to usually do this unless I have a camera on me, since I usually just leave the photography to those friends of mine who are better than me with a camera), participating in cosplay competitions, asking to glomp those people who

cosplay characters I like, getting fangirled (only recently started this) by others when in cosplay, meeting GoH that I like, and sometimes, just walking around. If karaoke's around, I'd do that too (only started recently).

At Yaoi-con, I also do almost all of the above, as well as Swap Meet, Bishounen Bingo (not participating myself, since I never get to win, and I find that with my unluckiness, I better not play), and Opening and Closing Ceremonies.

Hope that wasn't too much.
