PANEL DESCRIPTION

Yaoi-Con 2006 : October 20-22

Panel Descriptions

AMV: The impact of AMVs in Yaoi with instructions and pointers for aspiring vidders in creating their own regardless of experience.
Anatomy for Artists: <i>Piece by Piece, Building a Better Boy</i> A live demonstration of human anatomy, structure, the effects of movement and pose, and differentiating character style.
Asian Ball-Jointed Doll Workshop: Come and learn the tips and tricks, from sewing to suading.
Bleach Yaoi: <i>Shinigami Love!</i> Come and share your favorite pairings and general discussion of the hot shounen series.
Boy's Love, American Style: Write Yaoi? Published or want to be published? What options or support are available?
BL Seiyuu: The BL Seiyuu panel returns for its fifth straight year with focus on seiyuu roles in BL games, playing video clips from a variety of games, and more!
Comic Slash: Discussion panel about slash themes and fanfics of western comic books.
Cream Cheese Alchemy's UFO Musketeer Squad: A presentation of an in-progress shounen/sci-fi manga/stop-motion anime OP created for a CalArts master thesis project.
Fanfic U: A look at the writing and revision of fanfiction with focus on the improvement of overall writing skills.
Fanfiction: <i>Slashing through the Ages</i> An open forum discussion on the history of slash and yaoi writing and on the influences of shounen ai/yaoi sources.
Favorite Yaoi Manga-ka/Series: New to the genre? Come and share your favorites in Japanese and English Yaoi Mangas with other fans.
Getting over the Hump – Beyond the Basic Sex Scene: The all-important Sex Scene in adult-oriented Yaoi fanworks and ways even seasoned lemon writers can keep the genre fresh for themselves.
Gundam Wing Meet and Greet: A chance to meet up with all your friends with GDW fandom. Stop by and reconnect!
History of Yaoi: Benefit from Eliza's intensive research into the origins and development of yaoi in this informative panel.
How to Wear Kimono: A basic but thorough tutorial in how to properly wear traditional Japanese clothing (or how keep from being asked why you're walking around dead.)
Kingdom Hearts: Focus on the relationship between the original characters in the second game.
Kyou Kara Maou: A discussion of various pairings, themes and general fandom of the anime, novel and manga of KKM.
Leaving Reviews, A How-To: What makes reviews <u>good</u> , and the difference between a review, a comment, constructive criticism, and a flame.
Lucius Juice: <i>A Harry Potter Slash Panel</i> Exploring the world of Harry Potter, in and out of the closet.
Nanshoku: <i>Male-Male Eroticism in Edo Japan.</i> Eroticism between adolescent males and men. This panel will present its practice and how it changed over time.
Naruto: An overview of Naruto fandom in manga, anime and Doujinshi.
Our Resin Bishounen – Focus on Anatomy: We'll look at some of the latest yaoi-inspired BJD art, but the main focus will be on the varied anatomy of our lovely boys.
Pretty Boys on Acetate – Bishounen Cel Collecting: A quick intro to anime cel and sketch collecting; what's coveted and why, how they're used, and where to find them.
Production to Print: A basic tutorial of requirements, tips, and tricks to help yaoi writers and artists who want to get the best results from their commercial printers.
Racial Bias in Slash and Yaoi: Why certain characters seem to get overlooked in fanfic or in fanart, highlighting Asia's xenophobia in their art, as well as West's exclusions.
Real Media: For those who rather make it with their hands than on the screen! We'll cover and demonstrate a variety of mediums, papers, and print techniques.
Saiyuki/Kazuya Minekura: Covering the works of Minekura, particularly Saiyuki, and Saiyuki Reload.
Scholarly Passions: Our purpose is to form a working group for a scholarly project such as a book about yaoi that is serious and academically credible, but also reflects the fun that attracts fans to the yaoi genre.
Slash and Yaoi in Academia: Suggesting more theories to use in the discussion of slash and yaoi. How the two topics can apply to most fields, whether it is social, communication, media or theatre.
Slash vs. Yaoi: We will discussing the differences and the similarities between the two genres, plus going over which fandoms fall into which genre.
Stargate Meet and Greet: Fans and friends from the Stargate fandoms meeting up for like-minded company and socialization.
What a Girl (Gamer) Wants: <i>Yaoi Subtext in Video Games</i> When video games intended for boys end up yaoi fodder for girls; and wishful thinking on what the gaming companies offer next.
Weiss Kreuz: Florists by day, assassins by night. Join us as we go through the series' evolution and why it still draws fans today.
Yaoi PC Games: A discussion of the current Yaoi visual novels available for the PC with emphasis on the English translations.
The Yaoi RPG Ways and Means: We'll talk about the Whys and Hows of the Yaoi PRG. Examples from PoT fandom, but please bring your success stories from any fandom!
You Got Gay: <i>Prince of Tennis Panel</i> BL pairings and different aspects of the TeniPuri fandom. Brief summaries of the anime, manga, movie, and musicals for those who are less familiar.
Young Fans in Yaoiland: Looking at the influx of newer, younger fans and how they affect the yaoi community.
